Pā`ū Queen

- **Basic Requirements**
 - Candidate must be an experienced horseback rider.
 - Candidate must provide his / her own horse at their expense.
 - Candidate selected will be responsible for securing riders for her unit.
 - Candidate must be at least 30 years of age.
 - All unit riders must be of 18 years of age or older.
 - Unit riders must abide by the established Equestrian Rules & Regulations for the parade.
 - Unit members will properly acknowledge Kamehameha I as their unit passes the statue.

- **Description**
 - **Queen's Unit**
 - It is the responsibility of the unit to secure and / or rent their own mounts.
 - The selected Queen may not ride in the Pā`ū section again, but may ride in a private mounted unit.
 - No more than (13) riders.
 - (1) male banner page, (1) Queen, (11) a combination of male and female riders
 - The unit may consist of less than (12) but no more than (13) riders.

- **Dress**
 - Pā`ū skirts and kepola for the female riders and sashes & bowties for the male riders **may** be provided by the Commission, providing the color and quantity is available.
 - The Queen may choose to use their own personal attire for herself and her unit. Attire for the unit must be presented to the Equestrian and Parade Chair for **review and approval**.
 - The Queen may choose to use her own pā`ū wrapper/drapper.

- **Lei**
 - The unit is responsible to secure and provide all the flowers and foliage required to make the lei's for the unit.
