ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNOR JOHN WAIHEE Table of Contents

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INTRODUCTION

The records created or collected in the Governor's Office during the administration of Governor John 2. Waihee date from December 1986 to 1993. Except for a few photographs, the records are almost entirely letter-size papers and consist primarily of correspondence, although other types of material, such as reports and copies of legislative acts, are also present.

The records from Governor Waihee's first term were transferred to the archives on December 11, 1991. His second term records were transferred on December 20, 1994.

The records contain policy, planning and operational information on a wide variety of issues, including requirements for management of funds, shortages of personnel and high-profile public controversies such as the proposed Ka'u spaceport.

Access to the collection is restricted pending review of the records for social security numbers in compliance with HRS 487J. Other exceptions are specifically noted on the container list.

AGENCY HISTORY

The executive power of the State of Hawaii is vested in a Governor who is the Chief Executive Officer of the State. Voters elect the Governor for a term of four years. An individual may serve as Governor for no more than two consecutive full terms.

The duties of the Governor include executing all State laws, determining broad goals for the state, formulating and administering the policies and budget of the Executive Branch, and maintaining general control of Executive Branch departments and agencies, as well as offices, boards, commissions and programs administratively attached to the Governor's Office.

The Governor nominates and, by and with the advice and consent of the State Senate, appoints executive department heads, Supreme Court justices, intermediate appellate and circuit court judges, and members of boards and commissions. Vacancies in the State House of Representatives, certain vacancies in the State Senate, and vacancies on various boards and commissions are filled by the Governor.

The Governor's authority includes the approval or veto of legislation passed by the Legislature and the power to call the Legislature into special session. At the beginning of each legislative session, the Governor may report to the legislature the current affairs of the state and recommend measures for consideration.

Additionally, the Governor is the commander in chief of the armed forces of the State. He is also responsible for the arrangement of interstate compacts and is empowered to grant reprieves and pardons and take other quasi-judicial actions.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This record group currently consists of a single series of described records, Series 500, broken into two distinct time periods: Administrative Files of the First Term, and Administrative Files of the Second Term.

The records in this series are diverse, including statements of policy, examples of operating procedures and letters responding to a wide variety of issues. Also present are the comments and recommendations of government officials and the public on bills passed by the legislature.

The department-level files contain a dichotomy. Correspondence is filed as either "official" or "general." This dichotomy separates correspondence between the Governor and the department ("official") from correspondence with third parties about subjects for which the department was responsible ("general").

Filing practice included creation of "packages" of correspondence containing not only a letter and its reply, but also copies of background material, including prior correspondence. Such packages, which are filed in chronological order by the date of the last outgoing letter or response, often include material that will appear to be out of chronological order if its status as "background" is not understood.

Records of appointments to boards and commissions include those made by Governor George Ariyoshi, which carried over into the first term of Governor Waihee.

See also. Related records are contained in the records of other gubernatorial administrations, of the state legislature and of the executive departments.

Physical Characteristics/Condition: Consists of letter and legal-size manuscript, typescript materials; printed materials, brochures through folded oversize, including graphic art; and photographs, snapshots through 8 x 10 inch; all in good condition.

Content Description: Contains mostly correspondence, but also memoranda, minutes, acts, reports, site maps and graphed and tabulated data and statistics assembled during the first term of Governor John Waihee. The records reflect the diverse public issues and concerns that involved the Governor. These included handicap access, the location of a convention center, health care, protection of endemic flora, geothermal development, ocean mining, papaya irradiation, rampant litter, appointments to boards and commissions and complaints against the state and its employees. Although there is little in the records documenting development of policy, there are many cases in which existing policy is cited or inferred. The records with perhaps the most substance are the comments and recommendations provided to the Governor by his department heads and others on bills passed by the Legislature, discussing whether they should be enacted into law or vetoed.

Arrangement: Organized into two sub-series: administrative files and records of appointments to boards and commissions. The administrative files are arranged chronologically by year. Thereunder, each year's records are organized in order: records relating to functions managed by the Governor's Office and attached agencies; records relating to other government agencies, in order: Office of the Lieutenant Governor, state executive agencies, state legislature, state judiciary, counties, and federal agencies; and records relating to private organizations, individuals and subjects. Thereunder arrangement is alphabetical, either by agency name or by name of the organization, individual or subject. Within file folders, arrangement is generally in reverse chronological order. The records of appointments to boards and commissions are filed in alphabetical order by the names of the appointees.

Notes:

- 1. Records dealing with the Department of Planning and Economic Development are filed under "Department of Business and Economic Development," the name of the department from late 1987.
- 2. On the container list, which follows, file folder contents are correspondence unless indicated otherwise.

Physical Characteristics/Condition: Consists of letter and legal-size manuscripts, typescript materials, publications, and photographs. All are in good condition.

Content Description: The records of Governor Waihee's second term also consist mostly of correspondence. However, many reports for attached agencies and departments are included, along with administrative rules and organizational charts for each department, memoranda, minutes, and acts. The records depict many of the issues that the Governor's office handled during Waihee's second term, such as the decline in tourism caused by fewer visitors from Japan (records of the Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism (DBEDT)), the spaceport on Kauai (DBEDT), mass transit (Department of Transportation (DOT), the continued construction of the convention center (DBEDT), Hurricane Iniki (Department of Defense (DOD)), and health care (Department of Health (DOH)).

Arrangement: The records are organized by government departments in a hierarchical order: Office of the Governor followed by attached agencies; Office of the Lieutenant Governor; Executive Departments; Legislature; Office of Hawaiian Affairs; County Government; Federal agencies; then a listing of Organizations, Individuals, and Subjects. Under each department, the organization is chronological and then alphabetical. Within the folders, the records are generally arranged in reverse chronological order.

An exception to this order can be seen in each department's Administrative Rules. Departments generally revise related chapters of their administrative rules in groups. Departmental administrative rules are therefore arranged by groupings the department created during revision rather than by chapter number. However, each grouping is organized in numerical order according to the first chapter in the group. In addition, each chapter could have been reviewed in several groupings throughout the year.

Access: The records are restricted pending review for social security numbers in compliance with HRS §487J. Some records are also restricted under the Uniform Information Practices Act, HRS §92F. The folders that contain restricted material are clearly marked on the file folder label and in the container list. Reference staff must screen folders containing restricted records, while circulation staff will segregate restricted material prior to issuing to researchers.
