

O`AHU LEI DRAPING PROTOCOL

The following is the Lei Draping Protocol for the King Kamehameha Statue, on the Island of O`ahu per the guidance of and pursuant to Hawai'i Revised Statutes 8-5

- Lei to be approximately 30 feet in length
 - Only natural, biodegradable plant materials to be used
 - o Thread, string and kukui nuts are allowed
 - o RSVP by Monday prior to Lei Draping Ceremony to: kkcc@hawaii.gov
 - To include name of organization, short description, and whether group would like to present lei at the statue.
- Lei to be delivered to statue between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. to Ali'iolani Hale
 - Please label lei so emcee can make the necessary acknowledgements
 - Formal lei presentation:
 - King Kamehameha Celebration Commission
 - KKCC organizations
 - Hawai'i Congressional delegates, in person
 - Governor, State of Hawai'i
 - Mayor, City & County of Honolulu
 - Mayors present from other Hawai'i counties
 - Organizations that met the RSVP deadline
 - All others at the discretion of the King Kamehameha Celebration Commission
 - Floral arrangements and bouquets welcome, but no food items or candles
- Check in at Lei Check-In table, adjacent to the HFD firetruck
- Lei may be presented by group/organization to the designated receiver and logged, it is then placed on the lawn, after 2:00 pm the lei draping order will be designated and then draped by HFD.
- Lei will be grouped and draped at the discretion of the KKCC appointee and HFD.
