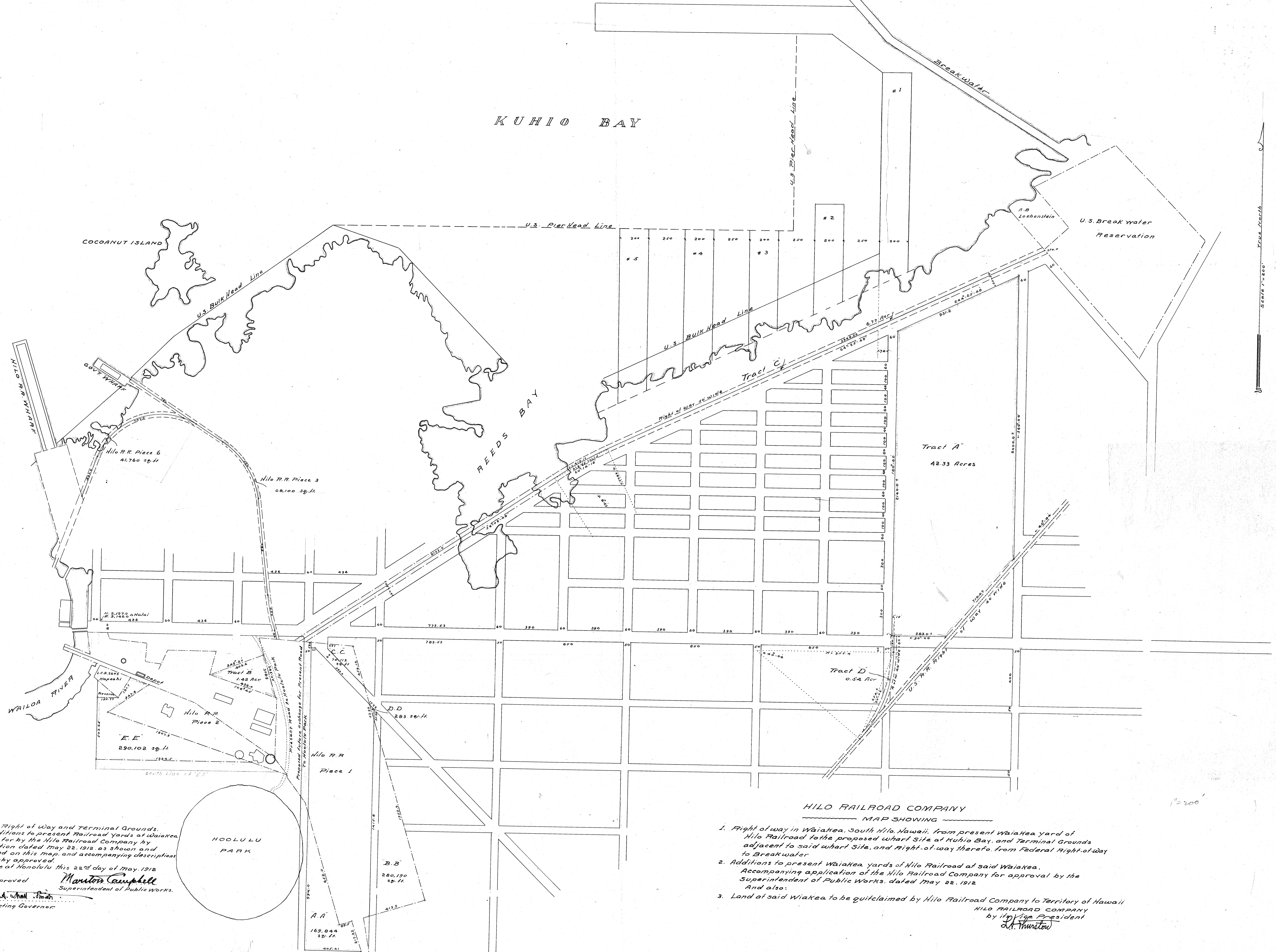


KUHIO BAY
