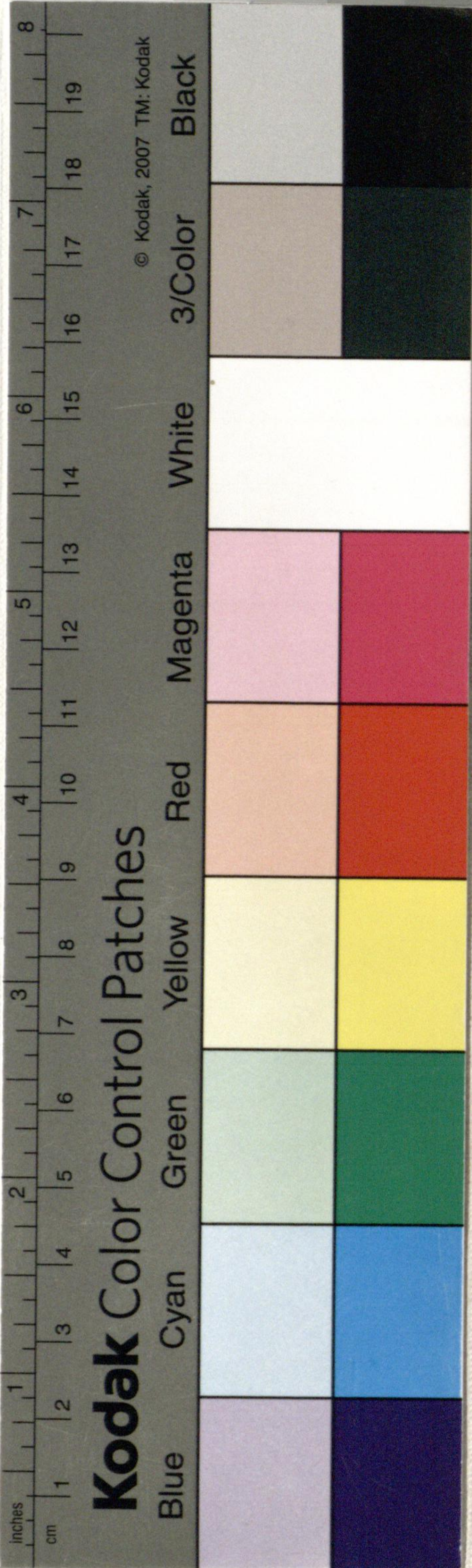

Sir,

delivered to me in presence of Mr. Dixon
by your Secretary Mr. Hoalilio. I beg leave
to state that I have come to the determi-
nation to lay the whole correspondence
circumstances before her Majesty's
Government and shall take the
earliest opportunity of claiming the
protection of my sovereign

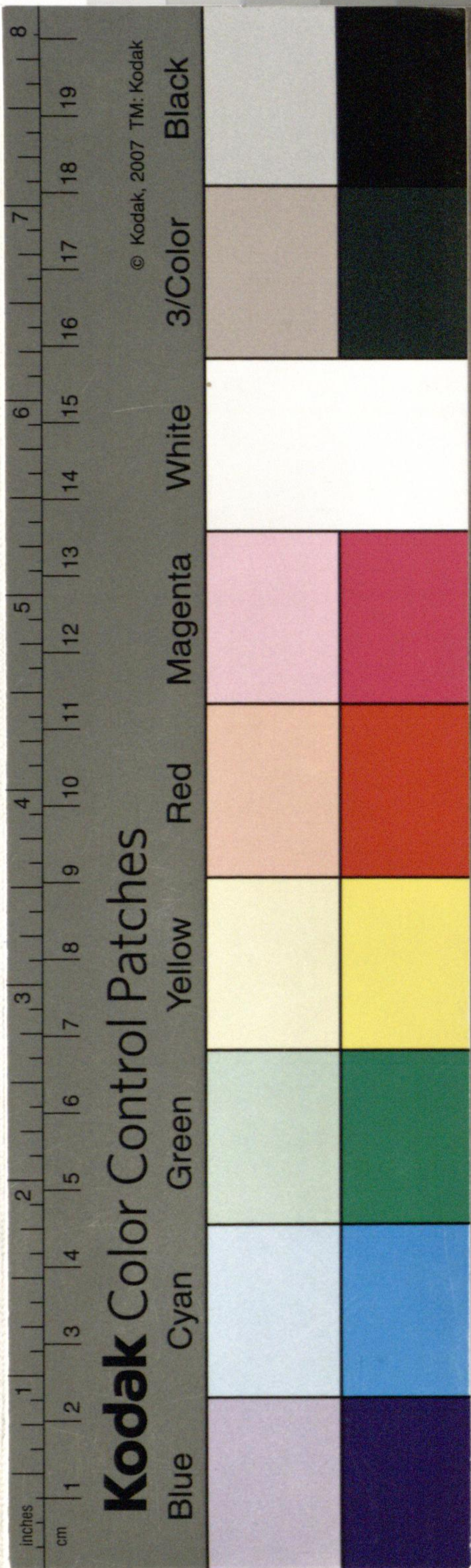
